### Planting a Vineyard:

### Choosing varieties:

There are so many variables to consider when short-listing or choosing your varieties. The obvious starting point is the style of wine you wish to produce. The UK is now capable of producing virtually all of the mainstream wine styles from full bodied red wines, rosé, dry aromatic, or sweet dessert whites, and increasingly, very high quality sparkling wines.

You will need to consider your site. The aspect, height above sea level, slope, shelter, soil, local flora and fauna may have a bearing on the suitability of certain varieties, and how well they will ripen.

Yield may also affect choice. If you are limited in area, you may wish to only plant higher yielding varieties.

Disease resistance may play a part, especially if you are considering organic or low input viticulture.

EC Wine Legislation should also be considered. Some varieties may not be applicable in the UK Quality / Regional Wine scheme and can only be sold as UK Table Wine without vintage, vineyard name or variety named on the label.

### About our vines:

Vine & Wine works closely with a large specialist grapevine nursery in Germany to deliver the best quality grafted vines, certified virus free & complete with EC plant passport. The vines are 1 year old stocks, pruned and with the graft union re-waxed prior to despatch. They are held in cold storage to keep dormancy until despatch from our premises. We normally despatch the vines mid April.

### Rootstocks:

Rootstock choice may be limited, unless ordering over 1 year in advance. We will endeavour to deliver the variety on the stock of your choice, but occasionally these may have to be substituted with another suitable rootstock. Common rootstocks are SO4, 125AA, 5BB, Borner, Binova and 3309 Courdec. Please ask for availability / suitability for your soil type.

**Please order as soon as possible, as popular varieties can be in short supply!**

1. Orders may be placed by phone, fax, email, or post.
2. Once we have confirmed availability, we will send an invoice for the full amount. You are required to pay a 50% deposit to confirm the order. The balance is due by the **end of March 2009** prior to despatch from the nursery.
3. Delivery will be by overnight courier at the rates listed, unless other specific arrangements have been made (e.g. collection).
4. Please contact us if you require specific delivery dates, otherwise we will inform you up to 24 hours prior to despatch of the delivery date.
